

DAS-140 FORM

(Title 8, California Code of Regulations, Section 230)

SUBMIT CONTRACT AWARD INFORMATION

Contractors shall provide contract award information to the apprenticeship committee for each applicable apprenticeable craft or trade in the area of the site of the public works project that has approved the contractor to train apprentices. Contractors who are not already approved to train by an apprenticeship program sponsor shall provide contract award information to all of the applicable apprenticeship committees whose geographic area of operation includes the area of the public works project. Submit contract award information to the apprenticeship committees for each apprenticeable craft or trade in the area of the site of the public works project that has approved the contractors, who are participants in an approved apprenticeship program, to train apprentices.

This contract award information shall be in writing on a DAS Form 140, Public Works Contract Award Information or a letter which includes the following information, required, pursuant to California Labor Code Section 1777.5.

- (1) Contractor's name, address, telephone number and state license number;
- (2) The full name and address of the public work awarding agency;
- (3) The exact location of the public work site;
- (4) Date of the contract award;
- (5) Expected start date of the work;
- (6) Estimated journeyman hours;
- (7) Occupation of Apprentice
- (8) Approximate number of apprentices to be employed;
- (9) Approximate dates apprentices will be employed.

The information shall be provided to the applicable apprenticeship committee within ten (10) days of the date of the execution of the prime contract or subcontract, but in no event later than the first day in which the contractor has workers employed upon the public work.

THE TOP SECTION OF THE FORM COMPLETELY FILLED OUT will provide the information required pursuant to California Labor Code Section 1777.5:

LOWER SECTION OF THE FORM: Check an appropriate box (#1, 2 or 3) for your status.

In addition to the "ORIGINAL(S)" mailed to all applicable Apprenticeship Committees, a "COPY" of this information shall also be submitted to Golden State Labor Compliance

The filing of a DAS 140 is not a request for dispatch of registered apprentices
